

# Crossroads Academy COVID-19 Guidelines for 2020-2021

## Travel and Quarantine Guidance

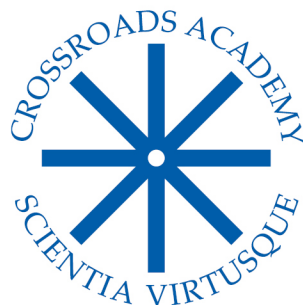
Crossroads Academy will follow guidelines set out by DHHS, New Hampshire's [Bureau of Infectious Disease Control](#) for travel & quarantine.

As of July 2, 2020 and lasting for an indefinite amount of time, **students, faculty, and staff who travel outside of New England** (NH, VT, MA, ME, CT, RI) **must quarantine within New England for 14 days before returning to Crossroads**, regardless of their mode of transportation and regardless of a negative covid test.

- Day 1 of quarantine starts on the last day of travel outside of New England.
- Per NH DHHS guidelines, **you cannot test out of the 14-day travel quarantine in New Hampshire.**

No matter how careful, safe, and diligent an individual is when traveling/visiting outside of New England states, travel increases a person's risk of contracting COVID-19. The state's travel guidelines/quarantine reflect this risk and applies it to *everyone* residing, working, or going to school in New Hampshire.

- The state's travel guidelines/quarantine applies to students, faculty, and staff *even if*:
  - tests negative for COVID-19
  - asymptomatic
  - only a privately owned vehicle was used for transport
  - coming from a privately-owned residence
  - other states deem the state/county you traveled from low-risk
  - no rest stops were used during traveling
  - extreme care and diligence to mitigate risk was observed while traveling

## COVID-19 Guidelines for 2020-2021

Travel Guidance for New Hampshire residents or those working or attending school in New Hampshire:

- Discourage personal international and domestic travel outside of the New England states.
- Even "asymptomatic persons who report one of the travel-related risk factors should self-quarantine for 14 days upon return from travel."

The state's travel/quarantine guidelines have been in place since *spring 2020* for residents or those working or attending school in New Hampshire. On July 2, 2020 the state relaxed the guidelines for travel/quarantine to allow return from New England states without quarantine. As the pandemic changes, the state's travel/quarantine measures may change throughout our academic year.

Crossroads Academy families, faculty, and staff will adhere to changes in the travel and quarantine guidelines set by NH DHHS. Please consider this in your fall/winter/spring travel plans. If your travel plans include traveling outside of New England, please be in contact with your child's teacher to get materials and information for their distance learning while they complete their quarantine.
